

SSH logging in and uploading files


After installing SSH two icons will be on your desktop




Always use the one that looks like a folder



Open SSH by double clicking on the icon




Click the **Quick Connect** button



Popup box will appear


Type **myweb.usf.edu** in the Host Name box

Type your **NetID** into the User Name box




The first time you login an additional screen will popup


Click **Yes**



Password box will popup
Type your **USF password**
Click **OK**




The SSH window is divided into two sections, the left-hand side shows your desktop files (local computer), the right-hand side show the web server (remote computer).




Public_html is the main directory (folder) for your web pages; in order to be viewed all files must go inside this directory.

The SSH toolbar has several icons for navigating through the files



On the Right-hand side, double click on **public_html** to open the directory
 On the Left-hand side, navigate to the location of your web files



To upload new files, or folders, to your web site simply click on the file, drag from the left-hand (local computer) to the right-hand (remote computer), and release.




New file will appear on the right-hand side.

To download a file or folder to your computer from the remote computer to your computer drag the files from the right-hand side to the left.



When either uploading, or downloading and the file or folder already exists a popup window will appear.

Click **Yes**



When you are done, exit SSH. Another popup will appear.

Click **OK** to exit.
